#### A note from Miss Comis to Grades 3 to 6

Dear WHCA Parents.

We are in the final term of the school year! Please keep watch over your students' grades as the end of the academic year approaches. Here is how music classes are being graded this term:

- Students in Grades K-2 receive participation grades.
- Students in Grades 3-4, 50% participation, 50% remembering to bring recorders and music binders to class
- Students in 5th Grade and above receive grades for participation, binder checks, bringing their instruments (if applicable), and projects.

Music class should be an easy A, and yet there is an alarming number of students in grades 3-6 whose music grades are declining towards Bs and even Cs due to chronically forgetting their class materials. This is worth a weighty grade to emphasize its importance. Students who forget their materials are unable to fully participate, which negatively affects both their own learning and that of the class as a whole. Students are frequently reminded during class that they are required to bring their music binders (and instruments if applicable) to every music class. They are strongly encouraged to keep their music binders in their backpacks so that they can easily access them for class and for practicing at home. Now is the time to get those grades back up and effectively help their classes prepare for our upcoming performances in the Spring Worship Night.
